It all started in 2005.

From the very beginning, we had a clear mission: promoting scientific vocations in Spain.

In 2006 we launched the *FIRST* LEGO League program, which offers young people the challenge of solving real-world problems by developing an innovation project and coding a robot. And that adventure that began 15 years ago in a small tournament with 16 teams, today has become the largest STEAM education program in Spain with more than 18.000 participants every school year.

This chapter is now over, we decided to move forward towards more accessible, scalable and sustainable programs with larger and measurable impact.

Proud of the job done, we are glad to share the first fifteen years' achievements that fuels our ambition and experience for -at least- fifteen more.



Integration of STEAM through out all educative phases





2019-2021

Program for the childhood phase, ages 4 to 6, that stimulates their curiosity for the STEAM and is developed in schools.

2011-2021

Program for kids aged 6 to 9 years that promotes the discovery of science and technology, through the design, construction and programming of a model and the presentation of an illustrative poster.





2006-2021

Program that introduces kids from 10 to 16 years to the exciting world of science and technology based on an experience that includes the Innovation Project, the Robot Game and the *FIRST* Values.

2012 2018-2021

Engineering program directed to teams -ages 16 to 18- that design, build and program robots, developing an strategy and creating alliances in FIRST Tech Challenge Championship.
